In Luxor, start your day with a magical sunrise hot air balloon ride over the Valley of the Kings, catching the golden light over ancient tombs — including that of Tutankhamun. Then dive deep into history with visits to admire the majestic columns of Karnak Temple.

Cap it all off in Hurgada, where you'll have the freedom to relax by the crystal clear waters of the Red Sea coast, with loads of adventure activities you can pick and choose, from diving into vibrant coral reefs to desert safari adventures across golden dunes.

### **Day 2: Giza Pyramids • Sakkara • Memphis**

Begin your morning with a warm welcome from our expert English-speaking Egyptologist guide, who will lead you into the heart of ancient wonders. Your first stop: the legendary Pyramids of Giza — Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure — where millennia of mystery tower over the desert sands. Standing guard nearby is the iconic Great Sphinx, carved from limestone and cloaked in myth.

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### **Day 3: Citadel • Grand Egyptian Museum • Egyptian Museum**

Start your day with a deep dive into Islamic Cairo. Our expert English-speaking Egyptologist will meet you at your hotel and whisk you away to the Citadel of Salah El-Din, a mighty medieval fortress that once served as Egypt's seat of power for over 700 years. Within its walls, marvel at the stunning Mosque of Muhammad Ali, with its sweeping views of Cairo's skyline and grandeur inspired by Ottoman design.

Next, head to the Grand Egyptian Museum — Egypt's dazzling new crown jewel. Be among the few to explore this state-of-the-art space that houses the most comprehensive collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts, including some never-before-seen treasures.

Pause for a satisfying lunch at a local gem, handpicked for authentic Egyptian flavours.

After lunch, visit the iconic Egyptian Museum in Tahrir, where you'll journey through millennia of pharaonic history, including the glittering funerary collection of Tutankhamun and the eerie mummies that once ruled the land of the Nile.

Optionally, cap off the evening with a magical stroll through Khan El-Khalili Bazaar — a historic souk teeming with color, spices, and old-world charm. (Night visit optional and payable on-site.)

#### **Day 4: Fly to Aswan • Explore the High Dam & Philae Temple**

After breakfast and checkout, our representative will meet you at your hotel and transfer you to Cairo Airport for your domestic flight to Aswan, the gateway to southern Egypt.

Upon arrival at Aswan Airport, you'll be warmly greeted by your expert Egyptologist guide to begin your southern adventure.

Start with a visit to the impressive High Dam, a monumental feat of modern engineering commissioned by President Gamal Abdel Nasser in the 1960s to regulate Nile flooding and power Egypt's growth.

Next, enjoy a scenic motorboat ride on the Nile, cruising towards the picturesque Agilika Island. Here, you'll explore the stunning Temple of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis — mother of Horus — and famed for its elegant Greco-Roman architecture and dramatic rescue from rising waters.

After this inspiring introduction to Aswan, you'll be transferred to your Nile cruise ship for check-in and overnight stay.

#### **Day 5: Sunrise at Abu Simbel • Kom Ombo & Edfu Temples**

Start your day with an unforgettable early morning journey to the majestic Abu Simbel Temples, one of Egypt's most iconic monuments. Carved directly into the mountainside, these twin temples of Ramses II and Queen Nefertari are a breathtaking testament to ancient Egyptian grandeur and devotion.

After returning to your cruise, continue sailing along the Nile to visit the Temple of Kom Ombo — a rare double temple uniquely dedicated to two gods: Sobek, the crocodile god, and Haroeris (Horus the Elder). Discover its fascinating symmetrical design and sacred healing halls.

Enjoy a leisurely lunch on the sun deck, soaking in panoramic views of the serene Nile as you cruise toward Edfu.

In the afternoon, step into a horse-drawn chariot ride through Edfu town, arriving at the magnificent Temple of Horus — one of the best-preserved temples in all of Egypt, where towering columns and intricate reliefs transport you back to the Ptolemaic era.

Return to the ship for a relaxing evening on board. Dinner will be served, followed by an entertaining Egyptian folkloric show hosted by the ship's crew.

## **Day 6: Hot Air Balloon • Valley of the Kings • Karnak & Luxor Temples**

Kick off the day with a breathtaking sunrise hot air balloon ride over the Valley of the Kings — a once-in-a-lifetime experience that offers stunning aerial views of Luxor’s sacred landscapes.

After breakfast on your Nile cruise, journey into Thebes’ storied West Bank, starting with the Valley of the Kings, the final resting place of Egypt’s most legendary pharaohs — including Tutankhamun. Feel the weight of history as you descend into the tombs of ancient royalty.

Continue to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, an architectural marvel carved directly into the cliffs of Deir el-Bahari. Then, pause at the iconic Colossi of Memnon, twin statues that have silently guarded the Theban necropolis for millennia.

Enjoy a relaxing lunch onboard as the cruise docks at Luxor’s East Bank.

In the afternoon, explore the majestic Karnak Temple Complex, the largest religious structure ever built, spanning over 100 hectares of sanctuaries, pylons, and obelisks dedicated to the gods of ancient Egypt.

Conclude your day at the beautifully lit Luxor Temple, a harmonious blend of pharaonic elegance built by Amenhotep III and completed by Ramses II.

Return to your Nile cruise for dinner and overnight, with memories of a truly magical day etched in your heart.

#### **Currency & Tipping in Egypt: What You Need to Know**

- USD is widely accepted in Egypt, and it's often easier than using Egyptian Pounds (EGP). Since it can be difficult to exchange SGD to EGP in Singapore, bring along some USD in small denominations — many places don't accept credit cards.
- ATMs are available at Cairo airport and in most major cities, where you can conveniently withdraw EGP.
- Tipping (a.k.a. "baksheesh") is a deeply rooted part of the culture. You'll be expected to tip for small services like using public toilets, taking photos in certain areas (e.g., around mummies), and more.



- To make things easy, carry a stack of small notes in Egyptian Pounds. A tip of 10–20 EGP is usually sufficient for simple services — feel free to give more if the effort or service is more substantial.
